ONLINE TRAINING

"Ensuring Student Engagement in a Technology-Enhanced Limited Face-to-Face Instruction"

Course Duration: 16 weeks (Start Date: September 5, 2022 | End Date: December 16, 2022)

Engagement : 54 hours (3.5 hours a week)

Course Fee : FREE (a PEAC-ASPIRE Project Grant thru ACSCU)

PARTICIPANTS: OPEN TO ALL TEACHERS, LIBRARIANS, AND STUDENT TEACHERS

(Private Basic or Higher Education)

CPD POINTS : 15 units

The training course is an upskilling activity on developing modalities, approaches, and strategies in the classroom to engage students during the limited face-to-face instruction. The upskilling will highlight skills and competencies in implementing limited face-to-face instruction emphasizing technology and pedagogy. It will be delivered in mixed modalities, hybrid, and hy-flex modalities.

Learning Outcomes:

At the end of the upskilling session, participants should be able to:

- 1. assess the different teaching modalities, approaches, and strategies for technology-enhanced flexible learning and limited face-to-face instruction;
- 2. use OER and other tools for the production and sharing of teaching resources;
- 3. develop policies and guidelines that are ethical, social, and legally accepted norms; and
- 4. recalibrate a syllabus or learning plan that is appropriate for post-pandemic instruction.

Prerequisites:

Participants must:

- 1. must be employed or enrolled in any private basic or higher education in the Philippines;
- 2. must have a desktop/laptop to be used for the entire online course;
- 3. have basic knowledge in ICT or at least know how to browse the Internet;
- 4. have access to a computer installed with the following software: Media (Video) Player, MS PowerPoint, PDF Reader, Google Chrome/Mozilla Firefox;
- 5. have access to the Internet for at least 3.5 hours a week; and
- 6. have an email account.

Speakers & Facilitators:

The Course Lead Facilitator is the Director of Silliman Online University Learning (SOUL). The upskilling program will be delivered by experts and trained teachers at SOUL Office, College of Computer Studies, and Technology Business Incubation Office, Silliman University. Course Format

- Modality: Hy-flex with bichronous learning
 - In-person (selected participants only) for selected topics at the Dr. Lao ICI Laboratory, Silliman University, Dumaguete City
 - Synchronous Online Session: Zoom (every last Monday of the month at 5:00 6:00 pm)
 - deepening, consultation, and Q&A with speakers & facilitators
 - Asynchronous: ourSOUL, the official learning management system of the course https://oursoul.su.edu.ph/lms
 - Listening to pre-recorded lectures (video), reading required lecture notes (PDF/web pages), participating in the weekly discussion, performing weekly knowledge checks, performing performance tasks, reading announcements
- Teaching Strategy: Flipped learning, micro-learning, gamification
- Pacing: class-paced with some self-paced activities
- Assessment:
 - O 10 Weekly knowledge checks (quiz) are set of objective questions (Multiple Choice, True/False, Short Answer) with a maximum of 20 questions. The assignments will typically be available on Saturday and close the Saturday of the following week.
 - 4 Performance tasks (submissions) are short computer hands-on activities related to the module.
 Some exercises are to be done in a group.
 - The final Knowledge Test is a comprehensive test covering the topics from the first day to the last day of discussion. There are 40 objective-type items.
- Certificates
 - Certificate of Attendance
 - A Certificate of Attendance per module will be issued for those who comply with the requirements of each module. A digital badge will be given for every completed module.
 - Certificate of Participation (15 CPD points)

A certificate of participation will be issued if the following requirements are met: 1) below 80% score but higher than 0; 2) submitted all the performance tasks; and 3) attended at least 50% of the online synchronous (zoom) session

- Certificate of Completion (15 CPD points)
 - A Certificate of Completion will be issued if the following requirements are met:
 - 1) those achieving 80%+ of the total points possible for all four modules;
 - 2) submitted all the performance tasks
 - 3) attended at least 50% of the online synchronous (zoom) session
